The ancient city of Hippos, one of the Decapolis, was erected upon the plateau of Sussita Mountain overlooking the Sea of Galilee which stretches west of it.

The Hippos dig is one of the main Classical Period excavations being conducted during last decade in Israel. This will be the 15th season of excavations that the team is lodged in the beautiful Kibbutz Ein-Gev on the eastern shores of the Sea of Galilee.
